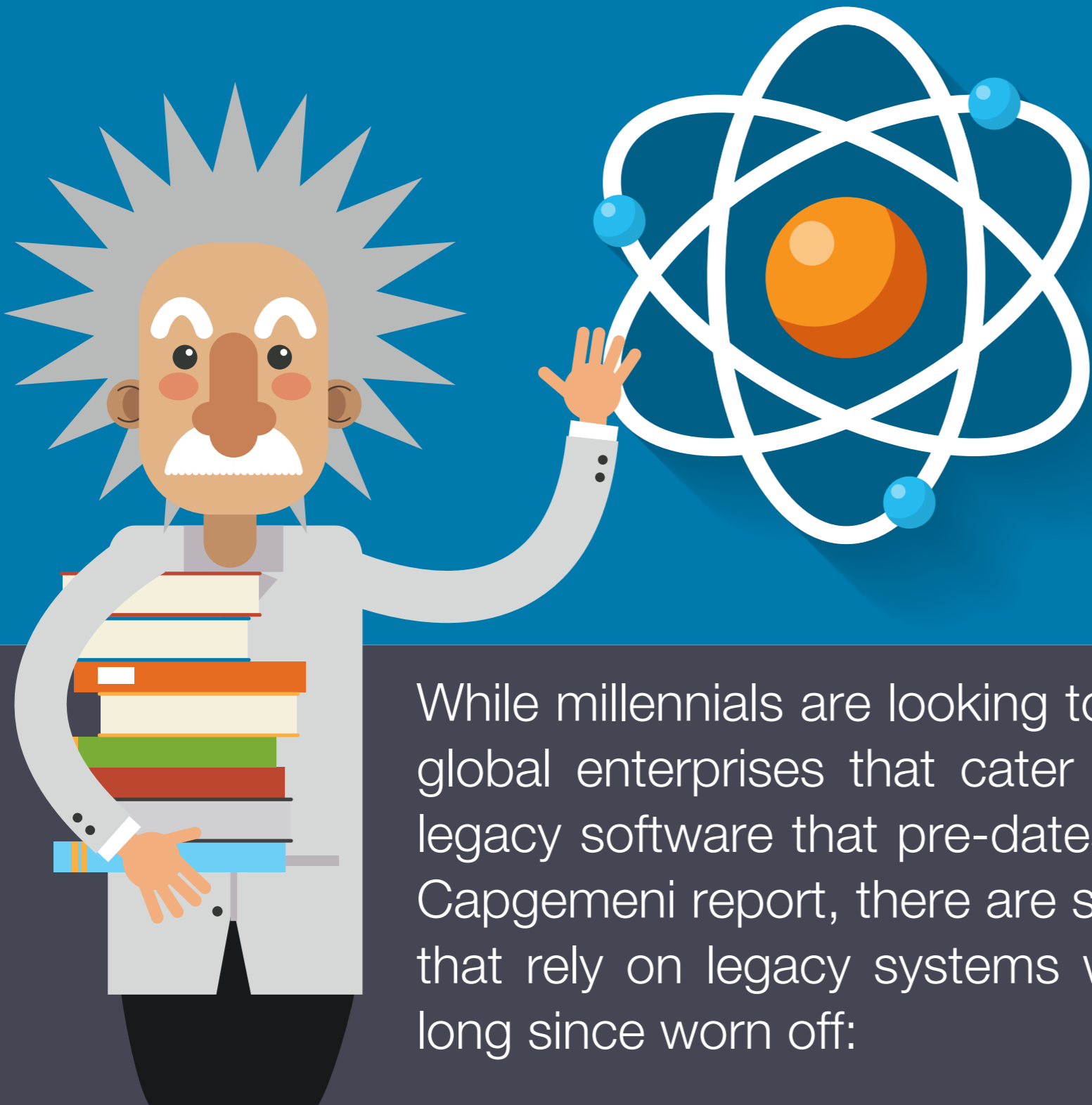


Risks to Maintaining Your Pre Y2K Software

SINGLE-POINTS OF FAILURE

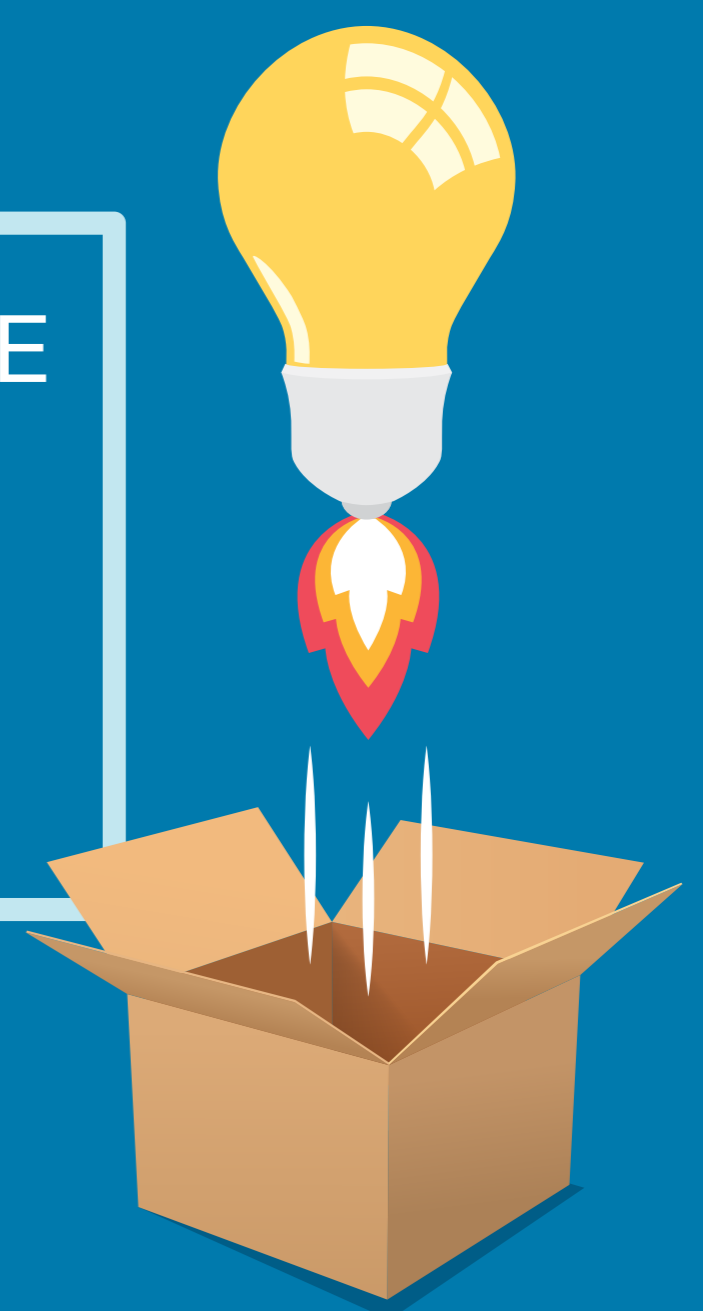
when using unsupported or obsolete hardware or software technologies
